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# Summer Day Camp Information Sheet - 2024

## **CAMP ENROLLMENT:**

Registration for the Pomeroy Recreation & Rehabilitation Center's Children & Youth Services Summer Respite Day Camp begins on **March 27th and ends on April 26th**. Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis due to limited spaces. Confirmations for Open Registration will be sent out by **June 14th**. Waitlists for the summer camp will open on **June 21st**, and families will receive notifications if space becomes available. All required paperwork (physical and emergency forms, immunization records, updated IEP, etc.) and completed intakes must be approved and submitted, along with all fees, by **July 12th** to finalize enrollment and secure a spot in our Summer Respite Day Camp.

#### **FUNDING SOURCES:**

- D. Private Pay (\$75 p/day, \$375 p/session Afternoon Prog. (12pm -6pm) & (\$50 p/day AM program (8:30am 12noon)
- D. State CHAN Scholarship Request (award process of scholarships are to be determined.)

Depending on the funding source, a one-time \$150 deposit may be necessary to secure a spot in the Summer Respite Day Camp. This deposit will be refunded at the end of the camp to families whose child attended at least 75% of the enrolled days or who were unable to attend due to a documented medical reason. Additionally, a \$25 non-refundable field trip fee is requested by June 21st to secure a spot in the camp. Families are responsible for fees not covered by GGRC. Financial assistance and scholarships may be available upon request.

#### **CHILD'S ELIGIBILITY:**

In order to be eligible for our services, your child must have a physical, mental, or emotional disability of such severity that the child cannot be adequately or appropriately served in a regular child care or development program as determined by the Individual Education Plan (IEP).

Subsequently, we venture into outdoor exploration, followed by outings across the San Francisco Bay Area using SF MUNI, BART, and Pomeroy Vans.
