



POOL OPENING PROTOCOL

Scheduling a Swim

All swimmers will be required to schedule their swim times with us over the phone in advance.

We will have no drop-in programs for the time being.

Swims are scheduled to begin on Monday April 5th 2021.

Swims can be scheduled up to 1 week in advance.

Each person may only schedule 1 swim at a time. For example, if you schedule a swim on Tuesday, you must wait until after you complete that swim to schedule your next swim.

In addition to scheduling your swims over the phone you can do so as you exit the facility after a swim.

Our front desk will be open with limited hours starting 1 week before Therapeutic Swim is scheduled to begin, Monday, March 29th, 2021.

Front desk hours for scheduling your swim:

* Scheduling must be done by speaking with a staff member. Please do not leave messages in an attempt to schedule a swim.

Friday	10:00am – 11:00am, 2:00pm -3:00pm, and 5:00pm – 6:00pm
Saturday	8:00am – 9:00am and 9:00am – 10:00am

This schedule applies for the time being. We will be adding more times and programs going forward as we are allowed.

Client Check-in

All clients will be required to wear a cloth or surgical face covering that covers both the mouth and the nose upon entering the facility.

Clients will be asked to arrive no more than 5 minutes before scheduled swim time.

Clients will line up outside the facility waiting for check in. We will have chairs placed 6 feet apart for them while waiting.

Staff will do a temperature check and have each swimmer answer a short questionnaire at the time of check-in.

Clients will be allowed to use benches on the pool deck, one swimmer/household per bench. Benches have been placed 6+ feet apart. Benches that cannot be moved that are within 6 feet of other benches will be blocked from use.

Use of the Pool

CDC recommends that individuals at high risk for problematic COVID infection that are not vaccinated refrain from using pools open to the public at this time.

We will only be offering Therapeutic Open Swim at this time, no Lap Swim or Exercise Class. Each open swim time will last for 1 hour.

In order to allow for social distancing, the total number of swimmers allowed for each scheduled swim time will be 10

Participants that are not from the same household must keep a minimum of 6 feet distance from others in the pool. We have markings on the side of the pool to indicate each swimmer's personal space.

Clients that are not swimming with their face/head in the water will be required to wear a face shield while in the pool. Please bring your own face shield if possible. We will have some available at the front desk if you do not have one.

Facility Use

While shower/changing room will be open at a limited capacity, CDC recommends that swimmers shower at home instead of at the facility if able to do so.

Shower/changing rooms will only be available to swimmers after their swim, not before, so please arrive dressed to swim.

Changing rooms will have spaces marked on the benches for participant use. These spaces will be a minimum of 6 feet apart.

Doors and windows to changing rooms will need to stay open to allow for increased air flow.

Showers will be made available; however some will be closed to allow for social distancing.

Shower/changing room use will be limited to 15 minutes for participants to allow time for staff to sanitize surfaces (benches, handrails, etc.) between swimming groups.

Shower and changing rooms may only be used for washing, drying, and changing. Using blow driers, brushing teeth, and shaving are all not allowed.

The suit spinner will not be able to be used.

Restrooms will be made available and both toilets and sinks have motion sensors to reduce physical contact.

Staffing

Many of our staff have already received both doses of the COVID vaccine!

Staff will be required to have a temperature check and complete a symptom questionnaire before the beginning of each shift.

Staff will be required to wear a cloth or surgical mask covering their mouth and nose while in the facility.

Between each patron group that uses the facility staff will sanitize spaces and surfaces that regularly get used, such as the lobby, changing room, benches, door handles, handrails, etc.

Cleaning schedules will be placed in the changing rooms for staff to sign upon each time they clean/sanitize.

Extra Precautions

While we will still be using our exhaust fans for air flow (which bring in fresh air, not circulate the air in the facility), we will also be opening doors and windows to the pool deck and changing rooms to further increase fresh air within the facility.

Water fountain will be blocked from use and clients will be encouraged to bring their own water with them.

Janitorial staff will do thorough cleaning and sanitizing of the facility at the end of each day

Additional Information

Each swim will cost the regular single-use fee for Therapeutic Swim: \$9.

10-swim passes may still be bought and used for these swim times.

Annual and Semi-Annual passes that were valid before we had to closed on March 16th 2020 can remain on hold to be used when the schedule returns to normal or the cost of the remaining days can be used to buy single swim passes or 10-swim passes.
