(oh, and we have a store - so let's go shopping!)



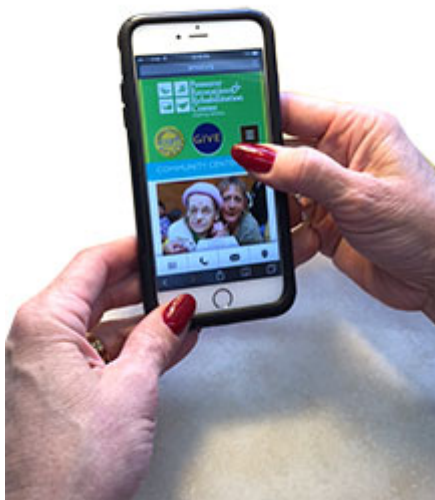
